Tiki Island to get new marina

Yacht Clubs of the Americas is planning to open a marina at Tiki Island near Galveston.

The Tiki Island Yacht Club is the newest member of Fort Myers, Fla.-based Yacht Clubs and the first developed outside of Florida and The Bahamas.

Located on more than five acres of the West Bay, the marina will feature 250 dry slips accommodating vessels up to 45 feet long, and 150 covered wet slips, accommodating vessels up to 100 feet in length.

Slip owner amenities will include a martini/cigar lounge, waterfront cocktail bars, tiki hut barbeque, spa, fitness center, swimming pool and restaurant. In addition, ownership entitles members to reciprocal privileges at any of YCOA's affiliated locations including Naples, Tampa and Key West, Fla. and Grand Bahama Island.
